Maintain a Healthy Lifestyle

Visit your medical provider for regular check-ups. Your primary care provider will screen for health risks and encourage you to keep a healthy lifestyle. Ask about mental and emotional health and ACEs.

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) are potentially traumatic events that occur in childhood. ACEs can include violence, abuse, and growing up in a family with mental health or substance use problems. Toxic stress from ACEs can change brain development and affect how the body responds to stress. ACEs are linked to chronic health problems, mental illness, and substance misuse in adulthood. However, ACEs can be prevented. Preventing ACEs can help children and adults thrive and potentially:

- Lower risk for conditions like depression, asthma, cancer, and diabetes in adulthood.
- Reduce risky behaviors like smoking, and heavy drinking.
- Improve education and job potential.
- Stop ACEs from being passed from one generation to the next.

Healthcare Providers Can:

- Anticipate and recognize current risk for ACEs in children and history of ACEs in adults.
- Refer patients to effective services and support.
- And link adults to family-centered treatment approaches that include substance abuse treatment and parenting interventions.

Raising awareness of ACEs can help promote safe, stable, nurturing relationships and environments where children live, learn, and play. Let's help all children reach their full potential and create neighborhoods, communities, and a world where every child thrives.
